

Minutes: City Council Special Meeting
June 16, 2014
5:30 PM

The Elkton City Council met in special session at City Hall, 71 Public Square, on Monday, June 16, 2014 with Mayor Nancy T. Camp presiding.

City Council members present: Eugene Jefferson; Jimmy Scott; Doug Gibson; David Haley; and, Danny Laster.

City Council members absent: David Powell.

Others present: Laura Brock, City Clerk/Treasurer; Ryan Craig, *Todd County Standard*; and, Adam May, WHOP Radio.

Mayor Camp called the meeting to order at 5:34 PM and reminded everyone only items on the agenda may be discussed.

Agenda

1. Committee Recommendation for Chief of Police
2. Appointment of Chief of Police
3. Discussion and/or Approval for Power Contract and Electric Billing for Elkton Die Casting Building

Mayor Camp reported the Committee appointed to recommend a Police Chief reviewed about five applications for the position. After brief discussion, committee member Gibson recommended Sergeant Brian Atkinson be appointed Police Chief. Motion seconded by Mr. Laster and carried unanimously.

Mayor Camp then recommended to the council the appointment of Sergeant Brian Atkinson to Police Chief effective June 20, 2014. Mr. Scott motioned to approve the recommendation and seconded by Mr. Jefferson and carried unanimously.

Mayor Camp presented a contract for electric service for the Elkton Die Casting property. This is a new Commercial contract that will replace the Industrial contract that was signed last year. The minimum monthly charge will now be \$18.40. The contract is for 5 years but is renewable every year. After discussion, Mr. Jefferson motioned to authorize the Mayor to sign the contract after it has been approved by City Attorney Jeff Traughber. Motion seconded by Haley and carried unanimously. There was also discussion if the city is to continue paying the bill since the lease agreement says the city will pay the electric bill for three months and then review. There was no action and this item will be discussed at the next meeting.

There were no further items on the agenda, therefore Mr. Jefferson motioned to adjourn and seconded by Mr. Laster. Motion carried unanimously and meeting adjourned at approximately 5:42 PM.
