Major Renovation

In 2020, we will start major renovation on our sewer system all throughout the city. We will be replacing old sewer pipe with new pipe or relining the old pipe. We ask you to be patient with the process, holes will be dug in many places in the city and some congestion will occur. All of the work is necessary to maintain and improve our system. More information will be provided later on the relining of pipe; which will use glue that you may be able to smell in your home if work is going on near you.

PLANNING AND ZONING

In 2020, our ordinances on Planning and Zoning will be studied to make needed changes and improvements these rules and regulations are always in need of study and change.

Some questions have been asked recently about the placement of house trailers in the city. A house trailer/mobile according to state law is not allowed in any zone. What are allowed are modular homes and manufactured homes; however, manufactured homes must meet specific qualifications to be allowed in a city zone and approval is on an individual basis. Contact city hall if you need more information on the use of modular and manufactured homes.
