## **City Growth for 2022**

We are looking forward to some of the progress being made in the city to come to completion; Work on the new Progressive eye clinic on the square and the new Family Dollar/Dollar Tree store that will be located on North Main, plus North Main is ongoing and will lead to new services in the city this spring.

New offices have been opened by Attorney Mark Collins on West Main and Attorney Nancy Calloway has relocated her office to the square.

Apartment work and duplex work is ongoing on Commerce Street and B White Road. On Industrial Drive, houses are being built and more housing is being planned in the city for the upcoming year.

Some other construction projects are in the works and I think we will see some of them in progress in 2022.

**Sewer projects:** Our phase 2 and phase 3 projects are moving forward. You can see some of the work near the high school and on Allensville Street. Phase 3 work is on the sewer plant and will improve our ability to maintain an efficient treatment process.
