

Minutes: City Council Meeting
April 18, 2019
6:00 PM

The Elkton City Council met in special session on Thursday, April 18, 2019 at 6:00 PM with Mayor Arthur Green presiding.

City Council members present: Michael Case; Doug Gibson; Danny Laster; Frank McReynolds; George Orr; and, David Powell.

Others present: Laura Brock, City Clerk/Treasurer; Terry Frogue, Utility/Street Superintendent; Justin Moberly, Zoning Administrator; and, Steve and Sue Rose.

Mayor Green called the meeting to order at 6:00 pm and led the Pledge of Allegiance. Mr. David Powell gave invocation.

Laster motioned to read the Summary of Ordinance 2019-04 in lieu of the entire ordinance, seconded by Orr, and carried unanimously. Clerk Brock read second reading of Summary of Ordinance 2019-04, "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION AND MAINTENANCE OF RESIDENTIAL DRIVEWAY ENTRANCE PIPES WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY." Powell motioned to adopt after second reading, seconded by Gibson, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Orr motioned to read the Summary of Ordinance 2019-05 in lieu of the entire ordinance, seconded by Laster, and carried unanimously. Clerk Brock read second reading of Summary of Ordinance 2019-05, "AN ORDINANCE CONCERNING THE INSTALLATION AND REGULATION OF STREETLIGHTS WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY." Orr motioned to adopt after second reading, seconded by Gibson, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Case motioned to read the Summary of Ordinance 2019-06 in lieu of the full ordinance, seconded by Powell, and carried unanimously. Clerk Brock read second reading of Summary of Ordinance 2019-06, "AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE PROPERTIES LOCATED ON COMMERCE STREET NEAR THE INTERSECTION OF B WHITE ROAD." Case motioned to adopt after second reading, seconded by Laster. Voting in favor of the motion by show of hands were McReynolds, Case, Gibson, and Laster. Voting opposed by show of hands were Orr and Powell. Motion carried.

Mayor Green stated item 7 does not need discussion due to the agreement already in place with the Water District for water line separation.

Mayor Green reported bids were received on Monday, April 15th for the City-County Park Lighting Project. Only two bids were received: Knight Electric, \$135,000.00; and Coffman Home Décor, \$105,777.39. The Coffman Home Décor bid was for materials only and did not include installation and therefore was not a valid bid. With the only valid bid remaining the project would be over budget. After some discussion, Mayor Green recommended the council reject all bids and rebid the project. Orr motioned to approve the Mayor's recommendation, seconded by Gibson, and carried unanimously.

Laster motioned to adjourn, seconded by Gibson, and carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at approximately 6:20 pm.
