### CITY OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY ORDINANCE NO. 2019-16

## AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 32.21 OF THE CITY OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY CODE OF ORDINANCES

WHEREAS, the City of Elkton has established by ordinance that meetings of the Council shall be held on the second Monday, unless the second Monday falls on a legal holiday; and

WHEREAS, the Council has determined it is in the best interest of the city to change the regular meeting date to the second Thursday and to establish an alternate date if the second Thursday falls on a legal or observed holiday.

NOW THEREFORE, be it ordained by the City Council of the City of Elkton, Kentucky that Section 32.21 of the Elkton Code of Ordinances is hereby amended as follows:

### § 32.21 MEETINGS.

- (A) Regular meetings of the Council shall be held once each month on the second Monday Thursday of each month at 7:00 6:00 p.m. based on the official time then prevailing throughout Todd County; provided, however, that whenever the second Monday Thursday of a month falls on a legal or observed holiday, then the regular meeting for that month shall be held on the ensuing Monday Tuesday which is a secular day at 7:00 6:00 p.m., or if such Monday is also a holiday, then on the ensuing Tuesday Monday. The regular meeting place at which the City Council shall hold its meetings shall be at the City Hall.
- (B) Special meetings of the Council may be called by the Mayor or upon written request of a majority of the Council. In the call, the Mayor or Council shall designate the purpose, time, and place of the special meeting with sufficient notice for the attendance of Council members and for compliance with KRS Chapter 61.
- (C) At a special meeting no business may be considered other than that set forth in the designation of purpose.
- (D) The minutes of every meeting shall be signed by the person responsible for maintaining city records as provided under § 32.41 and by the officer presiding at the meeting.

#### ARTICLE II.

If any section, subsection, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held unconstitutional or otherwise invalid, such infirmities shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions of this ordinance.

# ARTICLE III.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict with this amendment are hereby repealed.

## ARTICLE IV.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after its date of passage and publication according to law.
