

Minutes: City Council Special Meeting
October 15, 2020
5:30 PM

The Elkton City Council met in special session on Thursday, October 15, 2020 at 5:30 pm with Mayor Arthur Green presiding. Due to the current state of emergency regarding threats to public health presented by the novel coronavirus, this special meeting of the Elkton City Council was conducted in the Historic 1835 Courthouse Welcome Center, 1 Public Square, Elkton, Kentucky to maintain social distancing guidelines.

City Council members present: Michael Case; Doug Gibson; Danny Laster; Frank McReynolds; George Orr; and, David Powell.

Others present: Laura Brock, City Clerk/Treasurer.

Mayor Green called the meeting to order at 5:30 pm.

Clerk Brock read second reading of Ordinance 2020-09, "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE UPON THE ASSESSED VALUATION OF REAL ESTATE, PERSONAL PROPERTY, MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATERCRAFT WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY, FOR THE YEAR 2020." Case motioned to adopt Ordinance 2020-09 after second reading, seconded by McReynolds, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Case motioned to read Summary of Ordinance 2020-10, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE TEXT OF CHAPTER 151 (ZONING) OF THE CITY OF ELKTON CODE OF ORDINANCES" in lieu of the full ordinance, seconded by Laster, and carried unanimously. Clerk Brock read second reading of Summary of Ordinance 2020-10. Laster motioned to adopt after second reading, seconded by Powell, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Mayor Green presented a 2020 Pre-application for Hazard Mitigation Assistance through FEMA to help pay approximately 75% of the estimated total cost of \$300,000 for preparation of engineering plans and construction cost to breach the City Lake Dam. After discussion, Gibson motioned to approve submitting the pre-application, seconded by Orr, and carried unanimously.

Laster motioned to adjourn, seconded by Orr, and carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 5:35 pm.
