Sewer bids have been received for Phase #3, these bids were higher than expected and we will need to use our Federal ARPA funds and some additional funds to complete this project. This phase of the project is around \$1.8 million dollars.

Elkton City Lake bids have been received. The city has been under state order for a long time to take necessary steps to remove the dam from a high hazard status. The bid for breaching the dam was \$215,000. We are seeking assistance from the state and federal government to complete this project
