Streets to be paved: Elkton received \$43,050.00 from state discretionary road funds and the council has approved the bid from Scotty's Contracting & Stone to pave the following streets that were approved by the state: Weathers avenue, Kimberly Street, sections of Morningside Drive, , Deborah Street, and Micah Street.
