

Minutes: City Council Special Meeting
September 15, 2022
9:00 AM

The Elkton City Council met in special session at Elkton City Hall, 71 Public Square, on Thursday, September 15, 2022, at 9:00 AM with Mayor Arthur Green presiding.

City Council members present: Michael Case; Doug Gibson; Danny Laster; Frank McReynolds; and David Powell. Absent George Orr.

Others present: Laura Brock, City Clerk/Treasurer.

Mayor Green called the special meeting to order at 9:00 AM.

Clerk Brock read second reading of Ordinance 2022-11, "AN ORDINANCE FIXING THE AD VALOREM TAX RATE UPON THE ASSESSED VALUATION OF REAL ESTATE, PERSONAL PROPERTY, MOTOR VEHICLES AND WATERCRAFT WITHIN THE CITY LIMITS OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY, FOR THE YEAR 2022." Case motioned to approve after second reading, seconded by Laster, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Powell motioned to read the Summary of Ordinance 2022-12 in lieu of the full ordinance, seconded by McReynolds, and carried unanimously. Clerk Brock read second reading of Summary of Ordinance 2022-12, "AN ORDINANCE ANNEXING TO THE CITY OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY A 87.41 ACRE TRACT LYING ADJACENT TO AND CONTIGUOUS TO THE PRESENT CITY LIMIT BOUNDARIES EAST OF SOUTH MAIN STREET." Case motioned to approve after second reading, seconded by Gibson, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Clerk Brock read second reading of Ordinance 2022-13, "AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE ANNUAL BUDGET FOR THE CITY OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2022, THROUGH JUNE 30, 2023." Gibson motioned to approve after second reading, seconded by Laster, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Laster motioned to read the Summary of Ordinance 2022-14 in lieu of the full ordinance, seconded by Powell, and carried unanimously. Clerk Brock read second reading of Summary of Ordinance 2022-14, "AN ORDINANCE TO REZONE PARCEL ID 071-22." Case motioned to approve after second reading, seconded by Laster, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

Mayor Green presented Municipal Order 2022-08, "A MUNICIPAL ORDER AUTHORIZING AND DIRECTING THE REBATE OF UP TO ONE-HALF OF ONE PERCENT OF OCCUPATIONAL LICENSE TAXES DUE AND PAYABLE TO THE CITY OF ELKTON, KENTUCKY, FROM THE SALARIES, WAGES AND OTHER COMPENSATION TO BE PAID ON NEW EMPLOYEES OF DELAVAN AG PUMPS FOR A PERIOD OF TEN YEARS." Mayor Green reported the state requires 1% local incentive rebate to qualify for state incentive and in this case Fiscal Court will be rebating the other 0.5% of the local requirement. Case motioned to approve Municipal Order 2022-08, seconded by Powell, and carried unanimously by show of hands.

McReynolds motioned to adjourn, seconded by Powell, and carried unanimously. Meeting adjourned at 9:09 am.
