In Memory: We take a moment to honor and reflect on the life of former Mayor John E. Walton, who passed away on June 6, 2023. John served as Mayor of Elkton from 1999-2006. John passionately worked for progress in not only Elkton, but Todd County and Western Kentucky. He was serving as President of the Todd County Industrial Foundation and as Director of Marketing with Logan-Todd Regional Water Commission. As Governor Andy Beshear stated in a recorded message played during John's memorial service held Saturday, June 10th, "Today we honor the life of a strong, kind, and dedicated Kentuckian. Throughout his career, John led efforts to build a better Kentucky for his neighbors and Todd County. He did this with pride, celebrating what makes Todd County and all of Kentucky so special." John worked tirelessly to help make our community a better place to live, work and play and we will truly miss his generous heart and passion for Elkton and Todd County.

City Hall Activities:

1. Council approved a 2024 budget of over 9 million dollars.
 2. Work on the water tank on Morningside drive has been completed.
 3. Clearing of trees in the cemetery is taking place to remove old trees.
 4. Council approved change to Noise ordinance to extend construction hours.
 5. TAP Project on West Main is in the planning stage.
 6. Planning approved for use of park grant to replace lights on small field & playground equipment at the park.
 7. Council approved an ordinance to require all dog walkers to pickup their dog excrement from public & private property.
 8. Council approved approximately \$89,000 for paving to improve city streets.
 9. Planning started to improve & replace sidewalks around the city.
