Elkton-Todd County Park continues to improve. The ball fields are getting soil added & pitcher mounds & bases reworked. Design work is taking place for new lights for field 3, & depending on the remaining funds, some work will be done to replace the old playground equipment. Some walking path work will be done to replace some of the bad sidewalk in the near future.

The park can always use citizen volunteers to keep the trash & tree limbs pickup. The park belongs to all of our citizens & working together it is a great place for our kids & adults.

Projects in Elkton:

- 1. We are working to replace sidewalks around the city. Some replacement has already been done. The city just recently had Precision Concrete do some work to grind high spots to make the sidewalks safer.
- 2. This fall the city will be paving sections of our streets. Blacktopping cost will be around \$85,000.
- 3. Planning is on going on the TAP project for West Main as we move forward to have some utilities moved.
- 4. Plans are being finalized for the renovation of the front of City Hall & the Police Department. We look forward to a new look.
- 5. Goebel Avenue work is basically finished. However, we have some additional works to assist in the water flow.
