In a special recognition, Mayor Green acknowledged Captain Jakob Smith and Firefighter Justin Griffin for their quick and heroic response to a 911 call on October 31. The two were the first responders at the scene of a serious medical emergency involving a resident with a severe laceration. Their swift actions and lifesaving measures were credited with helping to stabilize the individual until further medical help arrived. The mayor expressed gratitude for the dedication and professionalism of these employees, who play a vital role in the safety and well-being of the Elkton community.
