Tax Rates

City Council approved the new tax rates for 2024, the approved rates are now lower than in 2023. The 2024 property tax rate will be \$0.241 per \$100 of assessment (down from the rate of 0.249 in 2023). The new personal property rate will be \$0.0968 per \$100 of assessment (down from 0.0971 in 2023). This rate will generate \$259,429.00 for operation of the city.



Updates on City Grants

We have received an Urban and Community Forestry Assistance Grant in the amount of \$42,201, to address the needs of trees in the city in public places and to provide forestry education

The energy grant to address the conservation of energy in city property was not approved. We are looking at an energy performance company contract to conserve and save energy.

The West Main TAP project is completing utility relocation and sidewalk plans to submit to transportation for their approval.

We have applied for grant funds to complete plans for a sewer extension to North Todd Elementary to assist in the needs of the school.
