Those elected will begin their new term on January 1, 2027. We encourage anyone passionate about Elkton's future to consider this opportunity to serve!

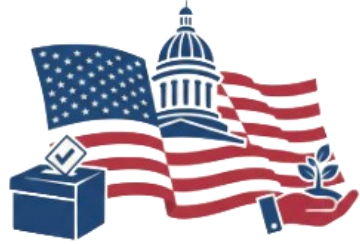
Stay Connected and In Control of Your Utilities
