### Improvements Underway

**Clock Tower Restoration:** Historic Todd County is giving every Todd Countian a fresh coat of paint on the old courthouse. With help from the Todd County Fiscal Court, the City of Elkton, and numerous local contributors, the heart of the public square will look better than ever. These efforts not only preserve our history but help keep our community vibrant, attractive, and a great place to live, work, and do business.



**West Main Project:** Work is underway near the Post Office to remove the large poles and place wires underground, install new sidewalks, and add parking beside the Post Office (with no parking directly in front). Additional sidewalk updates will continue in front of Food Giant, along with drainage improvements near Kinney's Tire Service.

**Preserving Local History:** The historic "Stepping-Up Stone" once located on the corner of W Main has been carefully moved to the Courthouse Square. Repairs will be made to help preserve the significance of this piece of history.
