City Projects & Improvements

Street Name Change: Industrial Drive #1, located on North Main, has officially been renamed **Soccer Way**. This street is the entrance to the new soccer complex currently under construction. New lights will soon be installed on the main field, with additional improvements planned through county grant assistance for lights on the other fields, concessions, bathrooms, and more.

West Main TAP Project: Construction is underway near the post office. Sidewalks are being replaced, utility lines moved underground, and poles removed. Once complete, **bollards will prevent parking street parking in front of the post office**, new sidewalks will extend to Food Giant, and a drainage pipe is being replaced to help reduce flooding. Please use caution in this area during construction.

Cemetery Updates: Several damaged trees and stumps have been removed, with more scheduled for removal next year. A replanting plan will follow. Monuments that have fallen are also being reset to improve the cemetery's appearance.

Fire Department Support: The City has entered into an agreement with **Emergency Solutions, Inc.** for fire run recordkeeping and reporting, and with **Cost Recovery Services** to help offset operational expenses.

City Finances & Grants

- **2025 Tax Rate Set:** The City Council approved a reduction in the property tax rate to **\$0.238 per \$100** of assessment. Personal property tax will be **\$0.1269 per \$100**. This will generate **\$280,065** for city operations, an increase of **\$20,636** over last year.
- **Parks & Recreation Funding:** The City approved a resolution to apply for **\$236,100 in matching funds** to install lights on Field 1 and build new pickleball courts in the park. If awarded, these grants will be available in 2026.
- **Housing Rehabilitation:** The City was not selected for funding in its second attempt to secure a scattered-site housing improvement grant. Due to project changes and other issues, we will not be reapplying.
